

## **Important Instructions**

Please read all operating instructions before using the appliance.

#### Do's

- 1. Before plugging the socket ensure that the supply voltage is in accordance with the rated one
- 2. Always preheat the sandwich maker before starting to cook.
- 3. While leaving, even for a short while, always unplug the appliance to avoid the possibility of fire.
- Children are not aware of the danger that can be caused by the electrical appliance.
   Therefore close supervision is necessary when the appliance is operated by or near children.
- 5. If the appliance is damaged, it must only be replaced by an authorized service personnel.
- 6. Avoid exposure of sandwich maker to heated surfaces or direct heat.

#### Don'ts

- 1. Do not operate the sandwich maker near flammable materials such as curtains, wall fabric, etc. as this could cause fire.
- 2. Do not push the detachable plate lock to open it when the appliance is in use.
- 3. Oversized foods, metal foil packages or any utensils must not be inserted in the sandwich maker as they may damage the non-stick coating of the heating plates.
- 4. Do not use sharp or abrasive items in contact with the cooking plate as this may also damage the non-stick coating.
- 5. Never put the power cord near to or in contact with hot surfaces of the sandwich maker.
- 6. Never immerse the sandwich maker in water.
- 7. Do not touch the heating plate while cooking as it may cause severe burns.
- 8. Never use the appliance if it is damaged anyway.

## **Before First Use**

After unpacking the unit and before any use, clean the surface of the plates with a damp cloth and some dish soap.

#### How to Use

- 1. Plug in and red light will glow ON. This indicates that the appliance is working. Let the appliance heat up sufficiently until the green light glows ON.
- 2. Slightly grease the heating plates with butter or cooking oil.
- 3. Now the appliance is ready for use.
- 4. Prepare the ingredients for your sandwich. For each sandwich or grill sandwich you need two slices of bread and a suitable filling.
- 5. The browning of the bread depends on the amount of filling used. To get better results, butter the sides of the bread in contact with the heating plates.
- 6. Lower the top heating plate on to the bread and lock the appliance.
- 7. When the green light glows 'ON' again, your sandwich is ready.
- 8. To make grill sandwiches, replace the sandwich plates with Grill plates.
- Use a non-metallic spatula to remove the sandwich. Do not use sharp or abrasive things as they may damage the non-stick coating.
- 10. Unplug the appliance after use.

#### Practical Advice

- For optimal results, filling should be proper and well placed within the sandwich slices.
- 2. Slightly grease the bread surface with butter to obtain better results.

## Cleaning and Maintenance

- Always remove the plug from the mains socket before cleaning the base. Allow it to cool down.
- 2. Push the detachable plate locks, and take off the two plates.
- Wipe the plates with absorbing paper towel or a wet soft cloth. They can also be cleaned under running water with soap water. Always wipe with a dry cloth before placing it back.
