

How to use

- Always ensure that the speed switch (2) is set to OFF position before plugging the unit in the power outlet.
- 2. Use high setting for drying hair & low setting for styling.
- 3. Plug in the hair drier to power socket specified in the technical specifications.
- 4. Adjust the desired position of speed switch.

Position 0: OFF

Position 1: For gentle drying and styling.

Position 2: For quick drying.

Safety instructions

- 1. Read all instructions before using the hair dryer.
- Only connect the hair dryer to a single-phase socket with a main voltage as specified on the rating plate.
- 3. The hair dryer should never be left unattended when plugged in.
- 4. Keep the cord away from heating surface.
- 5. Always unplug the hair dryer when not in use. Do not pull the cord to unplug the hair dryer.
- 6. Attachments & air outlet may be hot during use, allow them to cool before handling.
- 7. Switch OFF the appliance when not in use for long time.
- 8. Do not let animals or children touch or play with the hair dryer.
- 9. Do not cover. If covered, there is the risk of overheating.
- 10. If the cord of this appliance is damaged discontinue use of this product and contact the nearest authorised service centre.
- 11. Keep the hair dryer clean. Do not allow any objects to enter into the hair dryer as this may cause electric shock, fire or damage to the hair dryer.
- $12. \, Do \, not \, use \, the \, hair \, dryer \, for \, commercial \, purpose.$
- 13. Do not immerse in water or any liquid.
- 14. Do not use the hair dryer while bathing.
- 15. Do not place or store the hair dryer where it can fall or be pulled into a tub or sink.
- 16. Do not direct hot air towards eyes or other heat sensitive areas.

Cleaning and maintenance

- 1. Before cleaning, always remove the plug from the electrical socket.
- 2. Clean the hair dryer with a soft dry cloth.
- 3. Never use abrasive powders or solvents for cleaning.

Important instruction

The hair dryer is fitted with a safety device which will switch it off in case of accidental overheating (eg. obstruction of air intake and outlet, motor turning slowly or not at all). To reset, disconnect the plug from the power for a few minutes, remove the cause of overheating then plug the appliance in again.
